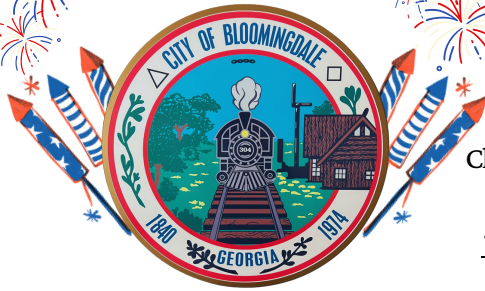

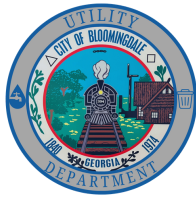
Town Center Park:

- Splash Pad: Exciting things are happening at Town Center Park! Our new splash pad is almost ready to go. We're just waiting on final approval from the Department of Health, and once that comes through, we'll share the date for the opening. Stay tuned!
- Other Amenities Being Considered: Swing set, benches, and playground covering

Infrastructure:

- Traffic Signal: Jimmy DeLoach Pkwy & Bloomingdale Rd: Construction will begin soon. | Est. Project Cost: \$846,189.50
- Traffic Signal: Hwy 80 & Maple St: GADOT has determined that a traffic signal is not warranted at the intersection of U.S. Hwy 80 and Maple Street. They explained that there have been no new developments in the area since 2022, and multi-residential projects without added commercial frontage typically do not qualify for a signal. Only current traffic volumes—not projected traffic—are considered when evaluating the need for a signal. Their study showed that the intersection did not meet the required qualifying traffic counts.
- Additional Water Usage: Mayor and Council voted on June 18th to amend to current Water/Sewer Agreement with the City of Savannah expanding the City's Water Service District with 1,000,000 gallons of water per day available within the Service District. A copy of the Service District Map is available at City Hall.

Preparing for Hurricane Season:

Surviving a small or large scale disaster depends on how prepared you are. You and your family's safety is largely dependent on how you prepare for emergency situations.

Building your own kit allows you to be familiar with the contents of it and how to properly use them. Putting together your own kit means you can custom tailor it to what's important to you, your family, and your community.

There are two types of kits to have ready:

- Stay-at-home kit (2 weeks of emergency supplies)
- Evacuation Kit (3-5 days in a "go-bag")

Approved Developments

- **Race Trac Travel Center:** Coming to Jimmy Deloach Parkway in Spring of 2028
- **Bloomington Business Park:** Will be located at 1109 East Hwy 80, and is a Commercial Flex Space
- **Faith Hope and Wellness Center:** Will be located at 201 West Hwy 80
- **The Culver Center:** Will be located at 1303 Hwy 80 and is a Commercial Flex Space
- **Hunt Midwest/ Northpoint LLC:** Will be located on Jimmy Deloach Parkway on the old D.K. Morgan property. The first building is underway and this is Industrial Warehouse Development.

Preparing for a Flood:

Residents and business owners need to prepare for flood conditions. Before the threat of flooding becomes imminent, residents and business owners should:

- Purchase a flood insurance policy if they do not already have one.
- Review their current insurance policy, become familiar with what is covered, and ensure the limits are adequate for their building and personal belongings.
- Make an emergency kit, plan evacuation routes, and keep important papers in a safe, waterproof place.
- Itemize and take pictures of possessions.
